Trade Circular

Sub: Extension of Policy for allocation of Berths for handling various

cargo/container inside the impounded Dock System of HDC.

Ref : This Office earlier circular no. MTO/G/104/Pt.X/55 dated

08.01.2019 (copy enclosed).

The Competent Authority of KoPT has approved extension of validity of the existing Berth Allocation Policy w.e.f. 16.06.2019 till further amendment/ modification is found necessary. The berth wise allocation of cargo is as follows:

Berth No.	Type of Commodity
3	Dry bulk cargo meant for direct delivery from the jetty as well as various break bulk cargo subject to non availability of facilities for handling such cargo at other berths. In addition Paraxylene, edible oil, HSD, SKO and Furnace Oil can also be handled at this berth. However, Sulphur & other hazardous/ dangerous dry bulk cargo will not be handled at Berth No.3.
4	Loading of thermal coal for coastal export. Handling of Edible Oil through pipeline.
4A	Handling of compatible dry bulk cargo through mechanized system as per the license agreement with ISHPL.
2, 4B and 8	All types of dry bulk cargo like Coal, Coke, Limestone, Clinker, Iron-Ore etc excluding food grains, sugar and other dry bulk material for human consumption. Break bulk cargo will also be handled at the said berths as per the provisions of Contract with the contractor(s) of KoPT. Paraxylene will also be handled at Berth No. 2.
5,6 & 7	Edible Oil and other liquid bulk cargo (except Class-A petroleum products) handled through pipelines having handling facilities at these berths. Berth no.5 will be also utilized for loading/unloading of barges.
9	Slow moving non-black dry bulk cargo primarily meant for direct delivery from jetty & break bulk cargo using ship's gears.
10 & 11	Container.
12	Clean dry bulk cargo and various break bulk cargo including project material and steel as per the license agreement with TMILL.
13	Clean dry bulk cargo like sugar, edible commodities (in dry bulk form), Other Non-Black Dry Bulk Cargo, Manganese Ore/Slag. Coal, Coke and other Black cargo can be handled if other MHC equipped Berths are occupied and clean cargo vessels are not available for handling at Berth no.13. Break bulk cargo will also be handled at this berth as per the provision of the contract with the contractor of KoPT.

However, since storage areas are not always available as per the allocation of Berths, intra Dock movement of cargo from one side of the Dock to the other side is unavoidable. This criss-cross movement of cargo carrying vehicles is hampering the overall productivity of vessels as the narrow roads in the Dock gets easily congested with such vehicles. Moreover, the lead time of vehicles gets increased if vessels are allocated Berths which are far away from the plots.

In order to resolve the issue, allocation of Berths of vessel working with MHCs are required to be planned considering the location of plots. If required, seniority of vessels may be compromised and a vessel may be kept waiting for few tides for a suitable Berth where plots are located nearer to it and criss-cross movement of vehicles can be avoided. The said arrangement will be valid for 3 months i.e. up to 15.09.2019 and will be reviewed thereafter.
