This is for information of all concerned that Risk Based Random Inspection System (RBRIS) has been introduced by DGFASLI with effect from 01 May,2017 for enforcing Dock Workers(Safety, Health and Welfare) Act 1986 and Regulations 1990 in all the major ports of India.

As per directive received from Inspectorate Dock Safety, requisite information/details are to be submitted by vessel agents at least 48 hours prior to arrival of vessels in port to the Directorate in the prescribed proforma (copy enclosed) along with requisite documents by e-mail on id rbris.ids@dghasli.nic.in in order to implement RBRIS in KoPT effectively.
