### TRADE CIRCULAR

#### Subject: Commissioning of RFID enabled Permit system

Kolkata Dock System, Kolkata Port Trust is in the process of implementing RFID enabled permit system across the various permit types in use.

For the rollout of RFID enabled permit system for Vehicles and Equipment entering docks it is necessary to start equipping the Vehicles and Equipment with appropriate RFID Tags that are to be affixed on the windshield for easy readability by the RFID Readers installed at the entry and exit gates.

The KoPT appointed vendor for the project M/s Comvision will commence issuance of such tags to all registered Vehicles and Equipment from **16.08.2019**. The cards will be available round the clock from counters at CPO, Subash Bhavan operated by M/s Comvision on payment of **Rs.57.75** plus applicable GST. Payment will be cashless and through Credit or Debit Cards.

For obtaining the RFID Cards for the registered Vehicles or Equipment, the owner will have to approach the counters operated by M/s Comvision along with **ORIGINAL Registration Document** of the Vehicles or Equipment **along with one photocopy**. The counter operator will check the details of the vehicles and equipment as per agreed procedure and issue the RFID tag after successful validation and collection of charges.

The owners of all registered vehicles and equipment are advised to procure the tags. On and from **06:30 AM of Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> Sept 2019 only RFID entry/exit** will be allowed for the vehicles and equipment holding term permits (i.e. monthly, quarterly or annual) from the following gates: **3 NSD, 4 NSD, 1 KPD, 3 KPD and 4 KPD**.

Other gates and other types of permits will be brought under RFID coverage in a phased manner, which will be communicated in due course. Also counters for issue of RFID Tags to new vehicles and equipment which are not registered in the database will be opened shortly.

Trade is requested to co-operate in the RFID roll out and problems faced during RFID implementation if any may be brought to notice of CPO for rectifications.
