
C I R C U L A R

Sub.: Facility for direct delivery of import FCL Containers
from the Docks / Container Terminal, KDS.

In partial supersession of this office circular of even number dated 29.2.2012 on the subject, it has been decided, in respect of CBEC registered ACP Clients, by the competent authority that the requirement of attaining qualifying volume of importation of at least 40 TEUs per month on an average, through KDS, during the period of six months previous to their date of filing of application for enlistment as new applicants or for continuation of their status as enlisted ACP Clients of KDS, would be kept in abeyance .

In other words, till further order, existing as well as future CBEC registered ACP Clients would be allowed to take delivery of their imported FCL containers at KDS directly from the Docks / Terminal, as at present, within the applicable time limit, without any additional volume based eligibility criteria attached.

In view of the above, submission of documents to this office by CBEC registered ACP Clients, in support of their importation of qualifying volume of containers, would not be required now.
