5. PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

A. Cargo Traffic:

- **During April 2016, KoPT handled 4.005 million tonnes (mt) of traffic** against 3.968 mt in April 2015, i.e. a rise of 0.37 mt (0.93%).
- **KDS handled a cargo throughput of 1.286 mt in April 2016** over 1.259 mt, in April 2015 i.e. a **growth of 2.14%**. **HDC handled 2.719 mt in April 2016 recording a growth of 0.37%** over 2.709 mt in April 2015.
- **KoPT registered growth in April 2016 vis-a-vis April 2015** in respect of Vegetable Oil, Other Liquid Cargo, Petroleum Coke, Other Coal/Coke, Fly Ash, Pulse, Container (TEUs & Tonnage), Limestone and Other Cargo.
- **Growth was registered at KDS in April 2016 vis-a-vis April 2015** for Other Liquid Cargo, Fly Ash, Pulse, Container TEUs & Tonnage and Other Cargo. **At HDC, traffic increased in April 2016 vis-a-vis April 2015** primarily for Vegetable Oil, Other Liquid Cargo, Limestone, Petroleum Coke, Other Coal/Coke, Fly Ash, Container (TEUs & Tonnage) and Other Cargo.

B. Container Traffic:

- **KoPT handled 59,547 TEUs in April 2016, registering a very high growth of 32.52%** over 44,936 TEUs in April 2015 against **3.94% growth registered by Indian Major Ports. KoPT ranked 3rd amongst all Indian Major Ports in terms of Container traffic during April 2016.**

C. Comparative Performance:

- **KoPT ranked 2nd in Other Liquid Cargo handling amongst Indian Major Ports in April 2016.**

D. Ship Traffic:

- **In April 2016, KoPT handled 285 ships; KDS 109 and HDC 176 vessels, respectively.**

E. Railway Traffic:

- **During April 2016, KoPT handled rail-borne traffic of 1.91 mt** (KDS – 0.47 mt, HDC – 1.44 mt). At KDS, number of **trains received and despatched was 134 and 107** respectively and at HDC, **294 trains were received and 299 were despatched** in the month under review.

F. Major Achievements:

- **Maritime India Summit (MIS) 2016 : KoPT participated** in the spectacular **MIS 2016 Road Show** in Mumbai from 14th to 16th April 2016 by organising a grand pavilion where various corporate films, interactive information kiosks, multimedia slides, brochures/books were screened/showcased, highlighting KoPT's rich heritage and history, achievements and contributions in the maritime circuit, which was visited by a wide cross section of enthusiasts and serious strategists, both domestic and overseas, drawing applause and appreciation from them. **During the course of MIS on 14.4.16**, the Hon'ble Shipping Minister opined that **Sagarmala Project** aims to reduce logistics cost and make both domestic and exim trade competitive.
- **Shipping through Eden Channel resumed since 18.09.2015 with two inward vessels M.V. Tina & M.V. Cape Kasos. Eden Channel has become fully operational from 29.02.16 for movement of all ships to and from Haldia.** In April'16, 358 vessels (176 inward ; 179 outward) have passed through the channel.
- **KoPT has been adjudged Container Port for the year 2015-16 by EXIM Group.** The Trophy and Certificate were presented in an award function on 6th May, 2016 in Kolkata. KoPT handled a record Container throughput of 6,62,891 TEUs in 2015-16 of which the contribution of Kolkata Dock System (KDS) was an all time record of 5,77,749 TEUs, clocking a growth of 9.2% over that of 2014-15.
