5. <u>PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS</u>

A. Cargo Traffic:

- KoPT handled 10.679 million tonnes (mt) of traffic in April-May 2019-20 vis-à-vis 10.113 mt in Apr-May 2018-19 registering a growth of 5.6% higher than overall growth of 2.5% for Major Ports. KDS handled 3.167 mt traffic in Apr-May'19 vis-à-vis 2.993 mt in Apr-May'18 recording a growth of 5.81% while HDC handled 7.512 mt in Apr-May'19 vis-à-vis 7.120 mt in Apr-May'18 i.e. a growth of 5.51%.
- KoPT had growth in Apr-May'19 w.r.t. LPG, Vegetable Oil, Other Liquids, Iron Ore, Other Ore, Other Coal/Coke, Petroleum Coke, Fly Ash, Gypsum, IVW traffic, Other Miscellaneous Cargo, etc.

B. Container Traffic:

KoPT handled 1,34,611 TEUs (KDS: 1,07,419 TEUs and HDC: 27,192) in Apr-May'19 and ranked 3rd amongst Indian Major Ports.

C. <u>Comparative Performance</u>:

- **KoPT** ranked 5th in Apr-May'19 in cargo handling among Indian Major Ports.
- KoPT ranked 1st in Coking/Other Coal, 2nd in Other Liquids and 3rd in Container handling among Major Ports.

D. Ship Traffic:

In Apr-May'19, KoPT handled 596 ships - the highest among Indian Major Ports. 734 vessels (367 inward; 367 outward) passed through Eden channel in Apr-May'19 to / from Haldia.

E. Railway Traffic:

In Apr-May'19, KoPT handled rail-borne traffic of 4.953 mt. (KDS-0.858 mt & HDC-4.095 mt) against 4.726 mt. (KDS-0.902 mt & HDC-3.824 mt) in Apr-May'18 registering a growth of 4.80%. In Apr-May'19, 207 trains were received and 203 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 806 trains were received and 814 despatched.

F. Major Achievements:

- The Hon'ble Consulate General of Australia visited Kolkata Port holding wide ranging exchanges on business / trade and developmental perspectives of the port.
- Swachhta contest was organized at HDC of KoPT for selection of awardees for best kept office/residence.
- With the upward revision of beam of vessels acceptable at Netaji Subhas Docks, from 80 ft to 82 ft (25m), M. V. Sentosa Trader of LOA-154.03m, Beam-25m, GRT- 13764 & DWT-16794, Flag-Malta, entered NSD for the first time on 24.4.2019 with a draft of 7.5 mtrs. The vessel under the agency of Shipping Corporation of India, handled 230 import TEUs & 165 export TEUs and finally sailed out on 26.4.19.
- Container operations started at Khiddirpore Docks, KDS of KoPT after more than a decade. Port crane Mahabahu is seen discharging containers from Bangladesh vessel Trans Samudera on 22.4.2019.
- KoPT celebrated the World Heritage Day on 18.4.2019 in association with Indian Museum, the National Library etc. The second Port Heritage Talk was delivered by eminent urban historian / cultural activist.
- The Honorable members of the office of the Consulate General of Germany, Italy, France and respected delegates from Bangladesh visited Kolkata Port holding wide ranging exchanges on business / trade and developmental perspectives of the port.
- > Interchanging of Lock Gate work has been recently executed at HDC. The outer lock gate at HDC has been replaced with a new lock gate which started moving after 25 long years which is a historic occasion for HDC.
