KoPT's Policy for Recruitment of Ex-Trade Apprentices

- a) There should not be any link or ratio between vacancies to be filled up by way of appointment of died-in-harness candidates on compassionate ground vis-à-vis appointment from ex-trade apprentices.
- b) The passed out trade apprentices, who had done their training under KoPT would be considered as and when direct recruitment in categories of posts matching their skills and qualifications, would be resorted to in KoPT.
- c) Other things being equal, a trained apprentice should be given preference over direct recruits.
- d) For this, a trainee would not be required to get his name sponsored by any employment exchange.
- e) In respect of age bar, relaxation to the extent of the period for which the apprentice had undergone training would be given.
- f) Selection amongst ex-Trade Apprentices will be based on merit.
