Subject / Work title : “Supply and Operation of 2 no. Ambulance on hiring basis for KDS for 3 years”

Pursuant to the queries raised by the intending tenderers & discussed in the Pre-bid meeting held on 12.07.2018

The representatives of the following prospective Tenderers attended the Pre-bid Techno-commercial conference held on **12.07.2018** for the tendered work:

- (i) **M/s R. K. Enterprise**
- (ii) **M/s Promod Kumar & Bros**
- (iii) **M/s Baba Loknath Enterprises**

All the points raised in the pre-bid meeting by intending tenderers as per the above list as well as those of the written submission as received from them as given below were discussed in details by the Tender Committee in its meeting held on **12.07.2018**. The Tender Committee has decided regarding clarification/decision against each of the queries raised by the intending bidders. Hence, such queries verbatim with the clarifications thereon made by KoPT as finalised and frozen are juxtaposed in the following tables against the respective clauses /terms of the tender.

A.1. Points raised by M/s Promod Kumar & Bros, Kolkata – 700 023 verbally during pre-bid meeting :-

1	<u>Age of vehicle</u> : Date of Registration of vehicle should be on or after 01.01.2014 instead of 01.01.2016 as mentioned in the Tender documents.	The date of Registration of the vehicle would be on or after 01.03.2015
2	<u>Security Deposit</u> : Instead of 10% of the total work value, kindly make it 5% of the total work value	Not accepted. The relevant terms of tender remains unaltered.
3	In case of non supply of vehicle as per tender terms minimum deduction of Rs. 2000/- per day should be amended to Rs. 1000/- per day.	The relevant terms of tender remains unaltered.

A.2. Points raised by M/s R. K. Enterprise, Kolkata – 700 023 during pre-bid held on 12.07.2018 vide their letter dated 11.07.2018:-

1	Age of vehicle: Date of Registration of vehicle should be on or after 01.03.2015 instead of 01.01.2016 as mentioned in the Tender documents.	The date of Registration of the vehicle would be on or after 01.03.2015
2	Security Deposit should be reduced from 10% to 5% of the tender value.	The relevant terms of tender remains unaltered.
3	In case of non supply of vehicle as per tender terms minimum deduction of Rs. 2000/- per day should be amended to Rs. 1000/- per day.	The relevant terms of tender remains unaltered.
4	Minimum detention charges:- How many hours?	Since it is a 24 hrs. duty vehicle, there will not be any minimum detention charges.
5	Kilometer Rate :- How many?	It is a tender based on hourly detention, there is no kilometer Rate.
6	Replacement of vehicle:- Instead of break down vehicle will be replaced within 2 hours (Kolkata) and outside of Kolkata make it 4 hours.	In case of breakdown of vehicle during duty hours, the time of replacement of vehicle should be within 2 hours, within which there would not be any hourly damage to be payable by the contractor as per Clause 5.7.1 of the Tender terms.

1	Clause 1.5(ii) of page-5 of tender document to be read as: "Experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 7 years ending 30 th June, 2018" in place of "Experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 7 years ending 31st March 2017"	
2	Clause B(VIII) of page-9 of tender document to be read as: "Self Attested copy of Work Order & Work completion certificate for similar nature of work carried out in Govt/Semi-Govt/Autonomous Bodies/Corporate Organisations/Reputed Private Organizations during the last 7 (seven) years ending 30.06.2018 and the experience should be either of the following as detailed below" in place of "Self Attested copy of Work Order & Work completion certificate for similar nature of work carried out in Govt/Semi-Govt/Autonomous Bodies/Corporate Organisations/Reputed Private Organizations during the last 7 (seven) years 31/03/2017 and the experience should be either of the following as detailed below".	
3	Clause No. B (XIV) at page -10, clause No.2 (C) at page-13 – The first para starting with 'The' and ending with 'out' stands deleted.	
4	Clause 1.(I) of page-12 of tender document to be read as: "Must have the experience of having successfully completed similar works during last seven years ending on 30 th June, 2018 as per the following guidelines" in place of "Must have the experience of having successfully completed similar works during last seven years ending on 30 th April, 2018 as per the following guidelines".	
5	Clause 2(b)(ii) of page-13 of tender document stands deleted	
6	In page 11 of tender document under Clause C(1), the word "proposal" should be replaced by "bid" in first line of C(1) and in first line C(1.i).	
7	Clause 2(b)(i) of page-13 of tender document to be read as: "Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with NSIC (under single point registration scheme) are exempted from depositing Cost of Tender Document and Earnest Money having valid NSIC Certificate for MSEs or DIC's (DISTRICT INDUSTRIES CENTRE) Certificate" in place of "Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with NSIC (under single point registration scheme) are exempted from depositing Cost of Tender Document and Earnest Money having valid NSIC Certificate for MSEs along with DIC's (DISTRICT INDUSTRIES CENTRE) Certificate."	
8	The last line of clause no. 2(j) of page 14 and clause no. 4.3(xvi) of page 20 of tender document to be read as: "An affidavit executed by a First Class Judicial Magistrate that 'the no. of employees of the tenderers' firm is less than 20' is required to be submitted" in place of "An affidavit executed by a Notary	

	that 'the no. of employees of the tenderers' firm is less than 20' is required to be submitted".
9	Item serial no. 16 of page 39 of tender document to be read as: "An affidavit executed by a First Class Judicial Magistrate that 'the no. of employees of the tenderer's firm is less than 20' is required to be submitted" in place of "An affidavit executed by a Notary that 'the no. of employees of the tenderer's firm is less than 20' is required to be submitted".
10	Clause 5.2.1 of page-22 of tender document stands amended and to be read as: "Vehicle must have date of 1 st Registration on or after 01.03.2015."
11	Clause 5.6 of page-23 of tender document stands amended and to be read as: "For ambulances booked for daily fixed duty, at least two drivers and two attendants along with vehicles shall be provided by the contractor round the clock, every day. If the contractor fails to do so, no payment shall be made for those days on which there will be either only one driver or one attendant or one vehicle."
12	Clause 13 of page-25 of tender document stands amended and to be read as: "Risk Purchase: Upon termination of the contract prior to expiry of the contract, for any of the reasons indicated above, KoPT shall be entitled to execute the balance work as per the scope of work at the risk and expenses of the successful bidder for the balance / remaining period of the contract and to recover the same from the terminated successful bidder in addition to any other amount, compensation or damages that KDS, KoPT is entitled to in terms of the other relevant clauses in the contract."
13	The following lines including Clause 31(B)(iii) of page-29 of tender document stands deleted: "Arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis:- If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total cost that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and the quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total cost will be amended accordingly."
14	Annexure-D' page no.31 last line of tender document "Other terms of the Scope of Work has been mentioned above" stands deleted.
15	Clause 32 of page-29/30 of tender document stands amended and to be read as: "The tenderers should submit their offer according to the BOQ mentioned in the tender document. The price quoted should include all charges for operating and maintaining the vehicle, except GST which will be paid extra at actuals".
16	The first portion of 2nd para of Clause 7(a) of page-7 of tender document to be read as: "As per MSME Act, 2006 (or Erstwhile NSIC Registered parties), parties will be exempted for submission of EMD and cost of bidding document" in place of "As per MSME Act, 2006 (or Erstwhile NSIC Registered parties), parties will be exempted for submission of EMD and cost of bidding document, provided party is registered for the similar nature of works as in the tender".
17	Clause 18(b) of page-26 of tender document stands amended and to be read as: "The amendment(s), if any, shall form a part of the Tender Document and will be notified by publication in the KoPT website and CPP Portal as corrigendum/Addendum and shall be binding on the prospective Tenderers."

All other terms and conditions of the tender shall remain unaltered.

The above Addendum shall be a part of the Tender Document as per terms of the original tender and the same shall have to be submitted alongwith the techno-commercial part of the tender.
