

ADDENDUM-2

With reference to e-tender nos. MSTC-ERO-KOLKATA-PORT-TRUST-57-KOLKATA-18-19-16135 & MSTC-ERO-KOLKATA-PORT-TRUST-58-KOLKATA-18-19-16136 bearing NIT Nos. KoPT/KDS/TFC/06-2018 & KoPT/KDS/TFC/07-2018 respectively, following information about the Charges to be levied from the party for handling & stacking / storage of Empty containers may be noted:-

I. Sl.4 of Annexure-IV should be read as:-

“Charges for handling and stacking of empty container to be levied from party shall be as follows:-

a. Up to 30 days:

Maximum Rs. 1200 per container (Irrespective of the size of the container).

b. After 30 days:

Additional maximum Rs. 500 per 30 days (Irrespective of the size of the container).

Note:

1. **Example:** If a party stores his container in the empty container stacking yard for more than 3 months (considering 30 days in a month), then he will pay maximum Rs. 1200 for 1st month, maximum Rs. 1700 for 2nd month, maximum Rs. 2200 for 3rd month and so on.....
2. Above rates / charges do not include taxes. Applicable taxes are to be paid as extra by the party.”

Instead of

“Charges for handling and stacking of empty container to be levied from party must be as follows:-

a) **Lift On / Lift Off Charges:** Rs. 100/- per container (Irrespective of the size of the container).

b) **Storage Charge**

a. Up to 30 Days:

Maximum Rs. 1000 per container (Irrespective of the size of the container).

b. After 30 Days:

Additional maximum Rs. 500 per container per 30 days (Irrespective of the size of the container).

Note: If a party stores his container in the empty container stacking yard for more than 3 months (considering 30 days in a month), then he will pay maximum Rs. 1000 for 1st month, maximum Rs. 1500 for 2nd month, maximum Rs. 2000 for 3rd month and so on.....”
