i) Rate of Bio Diesel is on F.O.R Loco Shed Store, P&E Divn. at Chiranjibpur, Haldia or any Site Store of M.O Division, HDC, Haldia including tax, loading, unloading, packing, stacking and all charges involved up to HDC's Store.

ii) Base price of Bio Diesel per litre as on 16.06.2016 = Rs 55.31
[Bulk Price of HSD (BS-III) of OMCs as on 16.06.2016 at Haldia] – (minus) Rs.6.00 per Ltr. = Rs 49.31 per Ltr.

iii) Quoted discount will remain firm during the currency of contract including the extension period.

iv) As GST Bill is under active consideration of Govt. of India, the same may be applicable if enactment of GST is done during execution of contract. Any benefit out of it has to be passed on to HDC.

25. PRICE VARIATION FORMULA:

Price variation on Bio Diesel shall be governed by the following mechanism. i) Price of Bio Diesel per litre=Bulk Price of HSD (BS-III) of OMCs (Oil Marketing Companies) ruling at the time of supply at Haldia – (minus) Rs.6.00 per Ltr. – (minus) Discount quoted by the tenderer.

Irrespective of whether order is placed on part or, on the whole of the BOQ no plea for subsequent withdrawal or the amendment will be entertained.

iii) The bidders, in whose cases **ED** is applicable, are to confirm the submission of admissible Cenvatable documents. The evaluation of the offer shall be made on the basis of landed price less Excise Duty (along with applicable Cess). If tenderer fails to submit Cenvat documents, amount of E.D will not be paid.

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28. TERMS OF DELIVERY:

Delivery Period shall be binding on the Bidder. If delivery of materials is not made within the time undertaken without sufficient reasons acceptable to the Trustees, the order may be cancelled without notice at the option of Trustees. In case of default in supply or, failure to deliver as per correct specification or the approved quantity within the time stipulated, Trustees are entitled to purchase from another source at the risk, cost and expenses of the supplier of the whole or, any portion of the supply remaining undelivered or unapproved. Materials shall be delivered by the successful Bidder at their own cost, risk and responsibility at different Store / Site of Haldia Dock Complex including unloading and stacking.

29. DELIVERY PERIOD:

Delivery would be made by the supplier up to Loco Shed Store, P&E Divn. at Chiranjibpur Or Any Site Store of M.O Division, HDC at their own cost, risk and responsibility within **15 days** from the date of receipt of each part order that would be placed (as per our actual requirement) within the contract including the extended period of contract. If the successful bidder(s) require(s) WAY BILL to execute the supply, in that case 10 days time will be required from the date of receipt of the bidder's request letter for issuance of WAY BILL by HDC to the date of receipt of WAY BILL by them from Haldia Dock Complex. 30. MODE OF DELIVERY:

31. DESPATCH ARRANGEMENTS:

The supplier shall send advance intimation as to the actual date of delivery of each and every installment of supply. Delivery of materials will not be accepted on Sundays and Holidays. The authorised representative of the suppliers must be present at the time of delivery for jointly noting with the representative of Ko. P. T. The discrepancies, if any, regarding the particulars of materials actually delivered against the challans will be noted. Delivery will not be accepted if not accompanied by authorized representative with proper delivery challans and other related documents like inspection certificates etc. No lorry shall be permitted to enter the protected area during nighttime. Detention of lorries, if any, will be on supplier's account.

32. TRANSIT RISK:

Transit risk will be on supplier's account since the delivery is to be made on F.O.R. Destination basis.

33. PACKING:

The tenderer would require to supply BIO DIESEL in returnable good condition 200 Itrs. Capacity barrels suitable for biodiesel supply with tamper and pilfer proof seal mentioning Manufacturer's name, Brand name, Product name, Volume of Content, Batch No., date of manufacture etc. Container should be free from contamination. Supply shall be made from fresh lot of manufacturing not more than one month old.

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34. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES CLAUSE FOR DELAY IN SUPPLY:

i) If the successful bidder (supplier) fails to complete the entire supply within the stipulated date or, such the extension thereof as communicated by the Manager (Materials Management Division) in writing, the supplier shall pay, as compensation (Liquidated Damage) to the Trustees and not as a penalty, @1/2 % (half percent) of the total basic value of the delayed portion of part order for every week delay in supply (part of the week being treated as a full week). Provided always that the amount of such compensation shall not exceed 10% of the total basic value of the part order.

ii) Without prejudice to any of their legal rights, the Trustees shall have the power to recover the said amount of compensation / damages as stated above, from any money due or, likely to become due to the supplier. The payment or deduction of such compensation / damages shall not relieve the supplier from his obligation to complete the supply order or, from any of his other obligations or liabilities under the contract. In case of the supplier's failure, and at the absolute discretion of the Manager (Materials Management Division), the work may be ordered to be completed by some other agency at the risk and expense of the supplier, after a minimum three days' notice in writing has been given to the supplier by the Manager or, his representative.

35. INSPECTION & TESTING:

Visual inspection will be carried out at the point of delivery after receiving the material. The material will be accepted on the basis of manufacturer's satisfactory test certificate and guarantee certificate. The materials supplied should strictly conform to the specification (i.e. IS etc. as applicable) against the items in our Tender/order. Samples as and when considered necessary by HDC, may be collected from the supply jointly by the supplier's representative and HDC's representative and the same jointly sealed and signed, will be sent for necessary testing / analysis at Government / Government registered/ recognized/approved Test House .The result of such test shall be binding on the supplier. If the material is found to be contaminated or if it fails to meet the requirement of the specification / characteristics of the product as per Test Results, the materials will be rejected in whole or in part and the supplier shall be debited with the cost of test and they would also be required to replace the whole lot of supply and / or refund the materials cost involved to HDC including the cost of testing within one month of such intimation by HDC.

36. <u>REJECTION OF MATERIALS</u>:

Notwithstanding the inspection and passing of samples as per clause no. 35, any material found to be defective in quality and not conforming to the relevant specification, shall be liable to be rejected and the supplier shall replace the same at his cost and arrangement at the earliest. Rejected materials shall be at Supplier's risk. They must be collected from the Trustees' Stores, H.D.C. within a fortnight from the date of rejection on observing usual procedure on the matter. If the contractor fails to remove. Such materials within a reasonable time, the Trustees shall have the right to dispose of the same and the Supplier shall have no claim against the Trustees in respect of the said rejected materials.

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37. **PAYMENT:**

Payment will be made on the basis of actual supply of the materials as per specification and satisfactory acceptance of the same against an order. Payment will be made within 30 (thirty) days of receipt of satisfactory acceptance note of full delivery and acceptance of materials at HDC's Loco Shed Store, P&E Divn. at Chiranjibpur Or Any Site Store of M.O Division, HDC and on submission of clear bill. The bills should be submitted in quadruplicate to Manager (M.M.)'s Office at Jawahar Tower alongwith necessary documents including original receipted challan duly signed and stamped by HDC's representative at the point of delivery. Payments shall be made through ECS/NEFT/RTGS mechanism at all

centers where such facilities are available in the bank. Accordingly bidders are requested to submit their bank Account No with the name and address of the bank along with the branch name and code number

38. **GUARANTEE PERIOD**:

The product supplied should be guaranteed for a period of 06 months from the date of supply & acceptance against any defect. If any defect develops within that period, the materials should be replaced free of cost by the supplier.

39. PERMITS:

The successful Bidder shall have to obtain dock permits from the office of the Manager (MM), HDC at Chiranjibpur or as directed for entry of their vehicles and workers into the Trustees' Stores for unloading and stacking of the material. Such permits shall be issued free of cost to the Bidder against receipt of proper application for the same during normal working hours on any working day.

40. **TECHNICAL CATALOGUE/ PRODUCT DATA SHEET:**

The bidders shall have to submit Technical Catalogue/ Product Data Sheet of their quoted product(s) alongwith their techno-commercial bids and copy of latest Test Certificate.

TEST CERTIFICATE: 41.

Manufacturer's Test Certificate or that from a Government / Government registered/ recognized / approved Test House or Laboratory are required to be submitted by the tenderer along with the supply showing the conformity to IS:15607.

42. FORCE MAJEURE:

In the event of either party being rendered unable by Force Majeure to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under the contract, the relative obligation of the Party affected by such Force Majeure shall upon notification to the other Party be suspended for the period during which Force Majeure event lasts. The cost and loss sustained by either party shall be borne by respective parties The Term 'FORCE MAJEURE' as employed herein shall mean acts of God, Earthquake, Floods and Hurricane / Cyclone, War, Revolution, Riot, Fire, Strike excluding Strike by the employees of the Supplier or their Subcontractors. Upon the occurrence of such cause the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid, shall notify the other party in writing immediately but not later than 7 (seven) days of the alleged beginning thereof giving full particulars and the satisfactory evidence in support of its claim.

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43. <u>RISK PURCHASE</u>:

i) If delivery of materials is not made within the time undertaken, the order will be cancelled without Notice; two consecutive failures to supply within time will entail removal of Tenderer's Name from the Approved List of Suppliers.

ii) In case of default in supply or failure to deliver as per correct specification or approved Quality within the Time stipulated, Trustees are entitled to purchase from another source at the risk, cost and expenses of the supplier (successful tenderer) of the whole or any portion of the supply remaining undelivered or unapproved. In case of risk purchase, extra cost will have to borne by the supplier.

iii) In the event of any rejection of materials at the time of Periodical Testing, the Rejected materials shall have to be collected from the Trustees' Stores, H.D.C. within a fortnight from the date of receipt of intimation from HDC and the same has to be replaced immediately. If the Bidder fails to remove the rejected materials, the Trustees shall have the right to dispose of the same and the Supplier shall have no claim against the Trustees in respect of the said rejected materials. In case of failure to arrange for replacement of rejected materials, Trustees are entitled to purchase from another source at the risk, cost and expenses of the supplier of the whole or any portion of the replacement supply.

44. WORKMEN COMPENSATION:

The successful bidders must cover his employees / workers, who will be engaged for delivery, unloading & stacking job at HDC's site, under workmen compensation act, fatal accident act and personal injuries insurance act for protection against any injury / accident and shall have to bear all the consequences and cost as applicable as per relevant acts.

45. JURISDICTION OF COURT:

The contract shall be governed by all relevant Indian Acts applicable within the jurisdiction of High Court at Calcutta.

46. <u>BANNED OR DE - LISTED CONTRACTORS</u>:

Bidders must give a declaration to the effect that they have not been banned or, de-listed by any Government or, Quasi-Government Agency or, PSU. If a Bidder has been banned / de-listed by any Government or, Quasi-Government Agency or PSU, the details of any such ban must be clearly stated along with relevant documents which the Bidder is to enclose together with Techno-Commercial Bid. Incorrect declaration or suppression of facts will lead to rejection of the Offer

47. <u>PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)</u>:

Suppliers and his workmen including driver & helper must use PPE i.e. Safety Helmet etc. at the time of supply of materials inside the Dock premises
