i) Pre-qualification criteria:

- 1. Valid GST registration certificate.
- 2. Contractor shall have "Valid Electrical Contractor's License issued by competent authority of State / Central Govt. in line with The Indian Electricity Rules, 1956".

ii) Scope of Work:

1. Power shut down will be provided by HDC, KoPT.

- a) Existing indoor, 11KV, spare HT Panels (2verticals) are to be dismantled from indoor, 11KV, HT Panels [7verticals] assembly at Intake sub-station of HDC. Dismantling involves disconnection and isolation of 11KV Busbars along with AC/DC control wiring during Power Shut Down. Proper sealing of exposed Bus bars against ingress of water and dust shall be done by 2Nos. suitable size, 2mm thick MS sheet and 2Nos. 20mm thick Bakelite sheet of suitable size for insulation. Painting of Ms sheet is also in the scope of the bidder.
- b) Disconnected control wiring shall be properly marked. If required, re-installation of required ferruling shall be done.
- c) Disconnected, 11KV, HT Panels (5verticals) assembly at Intake sub-station of HDC shall be made ready for commissioning for restoration of Power.

 - 6. If during execution of work any damage takes place in the property of HDC, the same will have to be mended good by the contractor at their risk, cost and arrangement. Otherwise the same will be repaired / replaced by HDC, either departmentally or through outside agency and the cost of repairing / replacement will be recovered from the contractor, along with overhead charges @19.25%.
 - 7. The Contractor should arrange, at their own cost, all necessary tools, tackles, lifting machineries, scaffolding, temporary lighting, transport etc., required for the execution of total work.

iii) Payment Terms:

iv) Completion Period:

The **Executed work** would have be completed within **45(Forty five)** days, from the date of placement of order or arrangement of site clearance.

v) Inspection:

vi) Guarantee:

The Contractor shall be responsible for making good, at their expense, any defect, which may occur before expiry above period.

vii) Gate Pass:

Necessary Gate Pass for entering into the Dock Area would be issued for the personnel, equipment, machineries, materials etc. of the contractor in connection with the aforesaid supply, on chargeable basis, as per rules then prevailing, on the basis of written request from the contractor.

viii) Liquidated Damage:

If the Contractor fails to complete the job within the stipulated date or such extension(s) thereof, as may be allowed by Engineer, HDC in writing, the Contractor shall be required to pay as compensation (Liquidated Damage) to HDC, KoPT and not as penalty, @ ½ % of the cost of unfinished portion of the work, for every week's delay(part of the week would be treated as full week), provided always the entire amount of compensation to be paid under the provision of this clause shall not exceed 10 % of the total contract value. HDC, KoPT may, without prejudice to any other method of recovery, deduct the amount of such damages from any money which is due or which may become due to the Contractor. The payment or deduction of such damages shall not relieve the Contractor from their obligation to complete the work or from any other of their obligations or liabilities under the contract. Taxes as applicable rate on LD amount if any will be levied
