## **Trade Circular**

## Re: Berthing of edible oil carrying vessels at Haldia Oil Jetty (HOJ)-III

In order to handle more number of edible oil vessels at HDC, KoPT has decided to handle the same at 3<sup>rd</sup> Oil Jetty (HOJ#3) outside the impounded dock w.e.f. 18.07.2016.

Accordingly, one 16" dia edible oil pipeline has been laid by M/s. Emami Agrotech Ltd. from 3<sup>rd</sup> Oil Jetty (HOJ#3) upto the Finger Jetty which will be used by all the edible oil importers on common user basis against payment of ₹40/- (Rupees forty only) per MT to Emami AgroTech Ltd. The individual importers will connect their existing pipeline to this new pipeline near Finger Jetty through hoses for receiving edible oil handled at 3<sup>rd</sup> Oil Jetty (HOJ#3).

They will also arrange compressor, pigs, hoses, operational personnel etc as would be necessary for handling their cargo through this pipeline at their own cost. However, only those edible oil vessels capable of discharging cargo at a minimum rate of 350 MT per hour will be accepted at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oil Jetty at the discretion of HDC/KoPT. Accordingly the importers during declaration of their vessels will indicate the rate of discharge of the vessel and their agreeability of receiving the cargo at that rate.

The above arrangement including the rate payable by the importers for availing the common user facility will be reviewed after two years.
