Sub.: Planning of vessels intending to utilize the services of Floating Cranes.

One Cape size vessel, M.V. Cape Mary, carrying around 1,65,173 MT of coal is expected to arrive at Sandheads in between 6th to 8th December, 2018. The vessel will discharge around 1,00,000 MT of cargo at Sandheads and the balance at Sagar as well as at the new Lighterage Point south of Sagar. To ensure seamless operation of the said vessel at Sandheads, both the Floating Cranes will be deployed there from 08th to 18th December, 2018.

All intending users of the Floating Cranes are requested to plan their vessels accordingly so that vessels waiting for Floating Cranes can be minimized. Further, in order to make advance planning for deployment of the Floating Cranes, the agents of the vessels, which require the services of the Floating Cranes should declare their vessels at least 15 days prior to reporting at Sandheads.
