TRADE CIRCULAR

Subject : Commissioning of RFID enabled Permit system


Kolkata Dock System, Kolkata Port Trust is in the process of implementing RFID enabled permit system across the various permit types in use. A vendor has been appointed who has commenced installation of various types of necessary hardware at the Dock Gates and development of software for some time now.

The first phase of the rollout of RFID enabled permit system involves permits for vehicles / equipment that enter the docks on the strength of daily permits. In order to commence RFID enabled permit system for Vehicles and Equipment entering docks on the strength of daily permits it is necessary to start equipping the Vehicles and Equipment with appropriate RFID Tags that are to be affixed on the windshield for easy readability by the RFID Readers installed at the entry and exit gates.

The KoPT appointed vendor for the project M/s Comvision has confirmed that they will commence issuance of such tags to registered Vehicles and Equipment from **From 04.03.2019 and issuance will continue till 19.03.2019**. The cards will be available round the clock from counters operated by M/s Comvision on payment of **Rs.57.75/-** plus applicable GST. Payment will be cashless and through Credit or Debit Cards.

For obtaining the RFID Cards the Vehicles or Equipment owner will have to approach one of the counters operated by M/s Comvision and mention the Registration Number of the Vehicle or equipment for which the cards are being requested along with **ORIGINAL Registration Document** of the Vehicles or Equipment along with one photocopy. The counter operator will retrieve the vehicle details from database (for existing vehicles) after matching the same with the ORIGINAL Registration Document. Collect the cost of the RFID Tag. Embed the vehicle details in the RFID Tags and hand over the same to the owner after entering the RFID TAG Number in the system and on the duplicate of the Registration Document. Once sufficient number of vehicles and equipment in the existing database has been issued with RFID Tags, counters will be opened for issuance of RFID Tags to vehicles and equipment which are not registered in the database.

The RFID Tags collected by the vehicle owners should be securely kept for subsequent affixing on the vehicles by trained personnel. Detailed program for affixing the tags on the vehicles will be intimated in due course.
