II CARGO THROUGHPUT:

- > SMP, Kolkata handled 26.340 million metric tonnes (MMT) of cargo during April August, 2023 vis-à-vis 25.604 MMT during April August, 2022, registering an increase of 2.87%.
- ➤ HDC handled 19.347 MMT of cargo during Apr -Aug, 2023 vis-à-vis 18.818 MMT during Apr -Aug, 2022 (an increase of 2.81%). KDS handled 6.993 MMT of cargo in Apr -Aug, 2023 vis-à-vis 6.786 mt during Apr -Aug, 2022 (an increase of 3.05%).
- ➤ HDC registered growth in respect of POL (Product), Other Liquid, Vegetable Oil, Iron Ore, Other Ore, FRM, Coking Coal, Other Coal / Coke(incl. Metallurgical Coke), Petroleum Coke, Fly Ash, Container TEUs etc. while KDS registered growth in respect of Finished Fertilizer, Other Coal / Coke, Timber, Pulses & Peas, Fly Ash, Manganese Ore, Container(both TEUs and Tonnage) etc. during Apr -Aug, 2023 vis-à-vis corresponding period of last year.

III CONTAINER TRAFFIC:

SMP, Kolkata handled 3,13,491 TEUs (KDS: 2,64,168 & HDC: 49,323) during Apr -Aug, 2023 vis-à-vis 2,91,543 TEUs (KDS: 2,43,890 & HDC: 47,653) during Apr -Aug, 2022, an increase of 7.53%. Both KDS and HDC registered **growth of 8.31% and 3.5%** respectively during Apr -Aug, 2023 vis-à-vis Apr -Aug, 2022.

IV SHIP TRAFFIC:

During Apr -Aug, 2023, 1355 ships (KDS: 525, HDC: 830) called at SMP, Kolkata vis-a-vis 1223 ships (KDS: 441, HDC: 782) in Apr -Aug, 2022, an increase of 9.23 %. 1666 vessels (830 inward; 836 outward) passed through Eden Channel during Apr -Aug, 2023 to / from Haldia vis-à-vis 1572 vessels (782 inward; 790 outward) during Apr -Aug, 2022.

V <u>COMPARATIVE PERFORMANCE</u>:

SMP, Kolkata ranked 1st in handling of Coking/Other Coal, 2nd in handling of Other Liquids and 3rd in handling of Other Misc. Cargo amongst Indian Major Ports during April to August 2023.

VI <u>RAILWAY TRAFFIC</u>:

During April to August, 2023, SMP, Kolkata handled rail borne cargo of 14.104 MMT (HDC-11.884, KDS-2.22 MMT) against 14.53 MMT (HDC-11.862 MMT, KDS-2.668 MMT) in April to August, 2022, registering a fall of 2 %. During April to August, 2023, 528 rakes were received and 531 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 2692 rakes were received and 2659 were despatched in the period under review.
