OFORDER UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC PREMISES (EVICTION OF UNAUTHORISED OCCUPANTS) ACT, 1971

WHEREAS I, the undersigned, am satisfied, for the reasons recorded below that M/S Salewell & Co, P-221/2, Strand Bank Road, Kolkata-700 001 is in unauthorized occupation of the Public Premises specified in the Schedule below:

REASONS

- 1) That O.P. has failed to liquidate the dues of the Port Authority, for a considerable period, in violation of the condition of the agreement between the parties.
- 2) That O.P. has failed to appear before this Forum and failed to show cause as to why order of eviction should not be passed on the O.P.
- 3) That O.P./any other person on behalf of O.P. have failed to make out any case in support of its occupation as "authorised occupation", inspite of sufficient chances being given.
- 4) That O.P. or any other person/s asserting any right through O.P. has failed to bear any witness or adduce any evidence in support of its occupation as "authorised occupation", inspite of sufficient chances being provided.
- 5) That the notice to quit dated 06.11.2003 as served upon O.P. by the Port Authority is valid, lawful and binding upon the parties and O.P's occupation, and that of any other occupant of the premises, has become unauthorised in view of Section 2(g) of the P.P Act.
- 6) That occupation of O.P. (including the occupation of anybody asserting any right through O.P.) has become unauthorised in view of Sec. 2(g) of the P.P. Act.
- 7) That O.P. is liable to pay damages for wrongful use and occupation of the Public Premises upto the date of handing over of clear, vacant and unencumbered possession to the Port Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Sub-Section (1) of Section 5 of the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971, I hereby order the said M/s. Salewell & Co, P-221/2, Strand Bank Road, Kolkata-700 001 and all persons who may be in occupation of the said premises or any part thereof to vacate the said premises within 15 days of the date of publication of this order. In the event of refusal or failure to comply with this order within the period specified above the said M/s. Salewell & Co, P-221/2, Strand Bank Road, Kolkata-700 001 and all other persons concerned are liable to be evicted from the said premises, if need be, by the use of such force as may be necessary.

FINAL ORDER

The matter is taken up today for delivering Final Order. It is the case of Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata (Erstwhile Kolkata Port Trust), hereinafter referred to as KoPT, applicant herein, that M/s. Salewell & Co. (O.P.) came into possession of the public premises Msg. 13.963 Sq.mts. of room space in the 2nd floor of KoPT's building known as P-221/2, Strand Bank Road, Kolkata- 700 001 comprised under occupation No./plate no. CG-165/A on certain terms and conditions as embodied in the short term lease and O.P. violated the condition of tenancy as granted by KoPT by way of default in making payment of the rental dues. It is argued on behalf of KoPT that O.P. has lost its authority to occupy the Public Premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice of ejectment dated 06.11.2003 and O.P. is liable to pay rental dues and damages for wrongful occupation of the Public Premises in question upto the date of handing over clear, vacant and unencumbered possession to the Port Authority.

It is argued that O.P. has no authority under law to occupy the Public Premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice of ejectment dated 06.11.2003 as issued upon O.P. by KoPT. This Forum of Law formed its opinion to proceed against O.P. under the relevant provisions of the P.P. Act and issued Show Cause Notice/s u/s 4 of the Act (for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of possession etc. of the Public Premises) and Show Cause Notice u/s 7 of the Act was also issued to O.P. (for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of arrear rental dues etc.) as per Rule made under the Act. Both the Show Cause Notice/s u/s 4 & 7 of the Act were issued as per

Rule made under the Act and both dated 21.05.2015. O.P. was asked to give reply to the Show Cause on or before 01.07.2015.

It reveals from record that Postal Service to O.P's address at P-221/2, Strand Bank Road, Kolkata-700 001 was returned undelivered with remarks of the Postal Department "Not Known" on 28.05.2015. A writ application also moved before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta by O.P. bearing C.O./C.R. No. 10848(w) of 1991 in connection with the KoPT's enhancement rent charges etc. stands dismissed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta on 08.08.2002. After consideration of the reports of the Process Server dated 02.06.2015, 09.07.2015, 04.08.2015, 11.09.2015, 01.10.2015, 04.12.2015 and 04.01.2016 regarding Affixation of Notice u/s 4 and u/s 7 of the Act on the Public Premises in question and orders passed on different dates by this Forum of Law on the Public Premises regarding fixation of date/s of hearing etc., I am satisfied with the service of notice to all concerned interested in the property as mandate under law.

In my view, sufficient chances have been given to all concerned to represent their case and O.P. has failed to submit its reply to the Show Cause Notice u/s 4 & 7 of the Act both dated 21.05.2015 inspite of sufficient chances. It is seen from the records and the recent Inspection report vide an application No. LND-8/56/21/899 dated 30.03.2021 that the premises in dispute is always found under lock and key.

As no one appeared on behalf of O.P. or on behalf of any person/s interested into the property inspite of several dates scheduled for hearing and no reply to the Show Cause Notice/s has been filed on behalf of O.P. or on behalf of any person/s interested into the property, I am left with no other



- 1. That O.P. has failed to submit any reply to the Show Cause Notice u/s 4 of the Act inspite of repeated chances.
- 2. That O.P. has failed to appear before this Forum of Law and has failed to bear any witness or adduce any evidence in support of its authorized occupation into the Public Premises inspite of sufficient chances.
- 3. That O.P. has defaulted in making payment of rental dues to Kolkata Port Trust in gross violation to the condition of tenancy under short term lease as granted by the Port Authority.
- 4. That the notice of ejectment dated 06.11.2003 as duly served upon O.P. by the Port Authority is valid, lawful and binding upon the parties.
- 5. That O.P. has lost its authority to occupy the Public Premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice of ejectment dated 06.11.2003 as issued from the Port Authority.
- 6. That occupation of O.P. (including the occupation of anybody asserting any right through O.P.) has become unauthorised in view of Sec. 2(g) of the P.P. Act.
- 7. That O.P. is liable to pay damages for its wrongful use and enjoyment of the Port Property in question upto the date of handing over of clear, vacant unencumbered possession to the Authority.

ACCORDINGLY, Department is directed to draw up formal order of eviction u/s 5 of the Act as per Rule made there under, giving 15 days time to O.P. and any person/s whoever may be in

It is my considered view regarding the payment of rental dues to KoPT, that a sum of Rs.1,21,643/-(Rupees One Lakhs Twenty One thousand six hundred and forty three only) (for Plate No. CG-165/A) for the period 01.06.1988 to 30.11.2003 (both days inclusive) in respect of the said premises is due and payable by O.P. and any person/s whoever may be in occupation, as claimed by the Port Authority in relation to the Plate in question, is correctly payable by O.P. for the aforementioned period and it is hereby ordered that O.P. and any person/s whoever may be in occupation, shall make payment of the aforesaid sum to KoPT by 22.07. 2021. Such dues shall attract compound interest @ 6.20 % per annum, which is the current rate of interest as per the
