1.	To list all the charges, their corresponding heads, and the mode of computation of such charges, payable to port, by the – (i) siding operator, (ii) user of the siding. All charges for the user of the siding who is providing MGV to the siding operator will be paid by the siding operator.	Charges payable to Port in respect of proposed lease of concerned land shall be in terms of provisions mentioned in the RFQ document & addendum/corrigendum thereof and includes the following: A. For Siding Operator (Lessee): (i) Applicable land rent, SD, etc. (ii) Applicable MGT charges for the proposed lease (iii) Applicable way-leave charges for laying any pipeline line/utility line/ Cable on SMP land.
