2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 2.1** Intending tenderer /bidder, either as a Single Entity or as Consortium, is eligible to participate in the tender. The term 'tenderer / bidder' used in this document would apply to either a Single Entity or a group of entities, i.e. a Consortium. A Consortium shall be eligible for consideration subject to the conditions set out in this tender document.

Note:

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this tender document, in the event of any member of any Consortium suffering from a Conflict of Interest, the offer of such consortium shall be treated as disqualified.
