Rates quoted should be both in figures and words. In case, there is any difference between rates quoted in figures and in words, only the lower of the two rates, quoted in figures or in words shall be construed as correct and valid.
- 3. The tenderer shall quote rate against each items of the 'Schedule of Rates' separately. No alternative mode of offer shall be accepted. Tenderer participating for part-A must quote their rate for both part A/1 and A/2 positively and vise-a-visa. Incomplete 'Schedule of Rates' shall liable the tender to be rejected.

1.	Scope of Work :	
	The work comprises supply and operation of buses for Part-A total 04 nos. buses (03 nos. 40 seater & 1 no. 32 seater) for transporting Trustees' employees and/or guests in and around the Haldia region in general.	
	For Part-B comprising 02 nos. 40 seater bus primarily for transporting CISF personnel and/or employees in and around the Haldia region in general and at times to other places within West Bengal e.g. Kolkata, Tamluk, Midnapore etc. for which any extra cost relating to route permit etc. shall be borne by the contractor.	
	The Haldia Region shall include Durgachak, Chaitanyapur, Brajalalchak, Kukrahati etc.	
	The buses shall also be utilized for transporting school children (dependants of the employees of the Trustees) from their residences to the school and back. The drivers and conductors of the buses shall be responsible for guiding and helping the students during their journey on the buses.
