This is an e-procurement event of Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata (Erstwhile Kolkata Port Trust). **The e-procurement service provider is RailTel's eNIVIDA Portal.**

You are requested to read the terms & conditions of this tender before submitting your online tender. Tenderers who do not comply with the conditions with documentary proof (wherever required) will not qualify in the Tender for opening of price bid.

1. Online tenders through RailTel's eNIVIDA Portal are invited by Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata from GST registered domestic Contractors for executing the work.

The tender document through RailTel's eNIVIDA Portal is open from 18.01.2021 to 03.03.2021 and can be downloaded from the official website of SMP, Kolkata and through RailTel's eNIVIDA Portal.

(A). Part – I (Techno-Commercial bid): Would be opened electronically on specified date and time as given in the NIT. Bidder(s) can witness the opening of Techno-commercial Bid electronically.

(B) Part – II (Price bid): Would be opened electronically of only those bidder(s) whose Part – I Techno-Commercial bid are acceptable by SMP, Kolkata. 5.	All notices / corrigendum and correspondence to the bidder(s) shall be sent by email only
	during the process till finalization of tender by S MP, Kolkata. Hence, the bidders are required
	to ensure that their corporate email I.D. provided is valid and updated at the stage of

11.	The bidders <u>must upload</u> all the documents required as per Pre-qualification criteria and the documents enlisted under techno-commercial bid and Price-bid, failing which the tender shall lead to disqualification. 12.	The bid will be evaluated based on the filled-in technical and commercial formats uploaded.
13.	The documents uploaded by bidder(s) will be scrutinized. In case any of the information furnished by the bidder is found to be false during scrutiny, EMD of defaulting bidder(s) will be forfeited. Punitive action including suspension and banning of business can also be taken against defaulting bidders.
14	Price bid must be filled-up in EXCEL Sheet through eNIVIDA PORTAL (which is uploaded by SMP, Kolkata).
15	Bid security declaration in the prescribed format at Annexure-I instead of Earnest Money . & Tender Fee should reach this office physically before opening of Tender document, failing which techno-commercial bid will not be opened.
16	Bid security declaration in the prescribed format at Annexure-I instead of Earnest Money . & Tender Fee details are to be treated as essential documents and should be uploaded with the other essential documents.

Terms and Conditions of Tender

1. Pre-Qualification Criteria of the Tenderer: The Tenderers shall satisfy the following:-

(I). <u>Technical capacity</u>: Must have the experience of having successfully completed similar works during last seven years ending on 31.12.2020 as per the following guidelines:-

(i). Three similar completed works, each costing not less than 40% of the estimated cost, i.e., Rs.64,00,000 /- Or

(ii). Two similar completed works each costing not less than 50% of the estimated cost, i.e., Rs.80,00,000/-. Or

(iii). One similar completed work costing not less than 80% of the estimated cost i.e., Rs.1,28,00,000/-

"Similar Works" means "Bidder should have experience of supply/maintenance of cargo handling equipment or should be an authorised dealer of the OEM/ distributor for cargo handling equipment"".

(II). <u>Financial capacity</u> : Average annual financial turnover of the Tenderer himself during the last three years ending 31st March, 2020 viz. 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019- 20 should be at least 30% of the estimated cost.

(III). Claims for fulfilling the above criteria viz. Technical and Financial Capacities must be supported with documents i.e., Work Order(s), Work Completion Certificate(s) from Client(s), Audited Balance Sheets including Audit Reports and Profit and Loss Accounts for the last 3 years viz. 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019- 20. In the event of non-submission of Audited Balance Sheet for the financial year ending 31.03.2020, the turnover for that financial year has to be submitted in lieu, duly certified by Chartered Accountant mentioning UDIN.

OTHER INSTRUCTION :

Following documents/papers are to be uploaded for techno-commercial part of the tender or any subsequent stage:-

1. a) Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque/Pay Order in original for Rs. 1770/- (Rupees One Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy only) as **cost of Tender Document** which also needs to be physically submitted to the Chief Mechanical Engineer, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Department, Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata, 8, Garden Reach Road, Kolkata -700 043.

c) The Tenderer shall have to upload documents (certified copy), viz. order letter and proof of completion to establish his credentials and related documents as asked for.

2. In addition to above as mentioned in Sl.No.1, following Scanned copies of self-attested documents are also required to be submitted online:

(a). Undertaking of the tenderer to be submitted in lieu of submission of signed copies of the Tender document in full, as per enclosed Pro-forma at ANNEXE -E.

(b). Tender Fee

(c). Earnest Money Deposit.

(d). Copies of Audited Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss Accounts of the tenderer for the last 3 years viz. 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 are to be furnished. In the event of non-submission of Audited Balance Sheet for the financial year ending 31.03.2020, the turnover for that financial year has to be submitted in lieu, duly certified by Chartered Accountant mentioning UDIN.

(e). Documentary evidence of successful completion of similar work as proof of fulfilling the Pre-qualification Criteria of the tender.

(f). GST Registration Certificate.

(g). Professional Tax Clearance Certificate/ up to date tax payment Challan, if applicable.

(h). Trade License/ Registration.

(i). PAN Card.

(j). Income Tax Return of last 3 years viz. 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20.

(k). Statement to confirm the status of the Tenderer – whether a Partnership Firm, Company or Proprietorship Firm. If demanded by SMP, Kolkata, the tenderer would be bound to furnish necessary documents in support of their statement in this regard.

(l). Profile of the tenderer containing full name and office address of the Tenderer, names and designation of the officials of the Tenderer connected with the instant Tender, their land and mobile telephone nos., e-mail id and Fax No. etc. as per enclosed Pro-forma at ANNEXE –B.

(m). Scanned copies of details of registration under ESI Act: All intending tenderer at the time of tender shall disclose all necessary documents as to whether they are covered under ESI Act or not.

(i).In case they are covered under ESI Act, they have to furnish the details of

registration, failing which their tender would be liable to be cancelled.

(ii).In case they are not covered under ESI Act or exempted, they would furnish necessary documents along with an Affidavit in original affirmed before a First Class Judicial Magistrate on a Non Judicial Stamp Paper worth Rs.10/- to that effect as per enclosed Performa at ANNEXE-C.

(iii).In case they are not covered under ESI Act, they must additionally indemnify SMP, Kolkata against all damages and accident occurring to his labour in a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper worth Rs.50/-. The same should be submitted along with Techno-commercial Bid as per enclosed Performa at ANNEXE-D.

(n).Details of registration under EPF Act: Intending tenderers shall have to furnish the details of EPF Registration, failing which tender/offer would be liable to be cancelled. Documentary evidences in support of non-applicability of registration under EPF Act shall have to be furnished.

(m). Declaration of the tenderer in the form of a COVERING LETTER that they have not been banned or delisted by any Govt. or Quasi-Govt. agencies or PSUs in India, as per enclosed Pro-forma at ANNEXE-I.

3. All the documents as mentioned here-in-before shall have to be <u>UPLOADED</u> or submitted offline as the case may be. The tenderer should clearly understand that no information/indication as to price should be entered in the page of "Bill of Quantities" or elsewhere in the Techno-commercial Bid. Indication of price anywhere in any manner in the Techno-commercial part of the tender would lead to rejection of the offer. Price bid which must be filled-up in EXCEL SHEET IN PORTAL which is uploaded by SMP, Kolkata.

4. No condition or conditional rebate should at all be indicated/mentioned in the Price Bid.

5. Tenderers may note that non-submission of any of the aforesaid documents/non-fulfillment of any of the aforesaid criteria shall lead to disqualification of their offers.

6. Techno-commercial bid would be opened on the aforesaid schedule date of opening the technocommercial bids. Price Bids of only the qualified bidders shall be opened on a suitable date, to be intimated beforehand.

7. The Trustees will not be responsible for any cost or expense incurred by the Tenderer in connection with preparation or submission of the tenders.

8. In case of unscheduled holiday, Strike/Bandh etc. on the scheduled date of Site Inspection, Prebid Meeting, submission of bids, opening of Techno-commercial or Price Bid, the same time (as per the schedule) on the next working day will be considered as scheduled time for the purpose of Site Inspection, Pre-bid meeting, submission of bids, opening of Techno- commercial or Price Bid, as the case may be. Here, Trustees' working day means Monday to Friday in between 9-30 hrs. to 17-30 hrs.

9. Should there be any doubt or ambiguity as to the meaning of any portion of the tender document or if any further information is required, the same shall be clarified/amended by SMP, Kolkata in the Site Inspection and Pre-bid Meeting. No excuse of ignorance in this regard shall be accepted at a later date after the Pre-bid meeting. In the event of making any important clarification or amendment of terms of the tender, pursuant to the discussion in the Pre-bid meeting or otherwise, the same shall be hoisted in SMP, Kolkata's website and https://kopt.enivida.in/only for information of all concerned and the same shall form a part of the Tender Document. The tenderers are requested to keep themselves informed of the development by visiting the said websites regularly. Such amendment(s) shall be binding upon them. Any offer having deviation from SMP, Kolkata's terms and conditions shall render such offer unacceptable to Kolkata Port Trust. No alteration shall be made by the Tenderer in the tender document and the offer must be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the tender. The prospective tenderers may inspect the site prior to the date of Site Inspection and Pre-bid Meeting in order to make themselves fully aware of the work, site and scope of work as mentioned in the tender. For attending the Pre-bid Meeting, the representatives of the tenderers should accompany proper authorizations letters from their respective organizations. The tenderers, however, before the Prebid meeting, can submit in the form of letters their doubt or ambiguity as to the meaning of any portion of the tender document and can sought for further information, if any is required.

10. Supplier/Service Provider to confirm that the GST amount charged in Invoice is declared in its returns and payment of taxes is also made.

11. The supplier/service Provider agrees to comply with all applicable GST Laws, including GST acts, rules, regulations, procedures, circulars and interaction there under applicable in India from time to time and to ensure that such compliance is done within the time prescribed under such laws. Supplier/Service Provider should ensure accurate transaction details, as required by GST Laws are timely uploaded in GSTN. In case there is any mismatch between the uploaded in GSTN by

supplier/service provider and details available with SMP, Kolkata, then payment to supplier/service provider to the extent of GST relating to the invoice/s under mismatch may be retained from due payment till such time Kolkata Port Trust is not sure that accurate tax amount is finally reflected in the GSTN to Kolkata Port Trust's account and is finally available to the Kolkata Port Trust in terms of GST Laws and that the credit of GST taken by Kolkata Port Trust is not required to be reversed at a later date along with applicable interest.

12. Kolkata Port Trust has the right to recover mandatory loss including interest and penalty suffered by it due to any non-compliance of tax law by the supplier/service provider. Any loss of input tax credit to Kolkata Port Trust for the fault of supplier shall be recovered by Kolkata Port Trust by way of adjustment in consideration payable.

13. Supplementary invoices/debit note/credit note for price revision to enable Kolkata Port Trust to claim tax benefit on the same shall be issued by you for a particular year before September of the succeeding financial year.

14. The purchase order/work order shall be void, if at any point of time you are found to be a blacklisted dealer as per GSTN rating system and further no payment shall be entertained.

15. The quoted rates would be kept valid for <u>at least 120 days</u> from the date of opening of the Techno-commercial Bid.

16. The Trustees' reserve the right to disqualify a tender in case they are satisfied that any bribe, commission, gift or advantage has been given, promised or offered by or on behalf of any of the tenderers to any officer, employee or representative of the Trustees or to any person on his or on their behalf in relation to acceptance of the tender.

17. The tenderers shall distinctly understand that they will be strictly required to conform to all the terms of the tender and the plea of custom prevailing will not in any case be accepted as an excuse on their part for infringing of any of the conditions and they shall refrain from sending revised or amended quotations, after the closing date and time of the tender.

18. The contract document shall be drawn in English language only. The contract shall be governed by all relevant Indian Acts as applicable only within the jurisdiction of High Court of Kolkata, West Bengal, India including the Acts like The Indian Contract Act, The Major Port Trusts Act, The Workmen's Compensation Act, The Minimum Wages Act, The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, The Dock Worker's Act, The Indian Arbitration & Conciliation Act, The Dock Safety Regulations, Act(s) or any other act, law, rule as may be applicable.

19. <u>Evaluation criteria</u>: For the purpose of qualification, the bidders shall have to satisfy the minimum Pre-qualification (experience and financial) Criteria as mentioned here-in-above. The details/documentary evidences under the Notice Inviting Tender, Instructions to Tenderes and Terms and Conditions of Tender shall have to be furnished. The bidders, who would qualify the eligibility criteria as per the Pre-qualification Criteria under the Terms and Conditions of Tender of the Tender Document, would only be considered for evaluation of technical and financial proposal. A two stage procedure would be adopted in evaluating the proposal viz. a technical evaluation and a financial evaluation. The technical evaluation would be carried out prior to opening of financial proposal. The Price Bids would be evaluated on the basis of the grand total price excluding the GST.

20. <u>Exemption</u>: Micro and Small Enterprise (MSEs) registered with NSIC (under Single Point Registration Scheme)/DIC(District Industries Centre)/Udyog Adhar shall be exempted from

payment of cost of Tender Document for which copies of valid MSE's Certificate along with NSIC Certificate/DIC Certificate with list of items registered must be submitted in techno-commercial part of their offer for claim of such exemption otherwise their offer will be rejected. But all MSEs registered with NSIC /DIC are not exempted from depositing cost of tender document. Only those firms, having documents of such exemption for the whole tender work (as per Scope of Work) will be exempted. Documentary evidence must be submitted in techno-commercial part of Tender for claim of such exemption, failing which their tender would be summarily rejected.

21. <u>Scrutiny of e-tenderers</u> :- During the course of examination of the Techno- commercial Bid, the bidders, if asked for, shall furnish any or additional document(s) for the purpose of evaluation of his/their bids.

22. During evaluation of the tender, an offer shall be considered non-responsive in case:

- (i) the tender is not accompanied by requisite Tender Fee,
- (ii) the tender is not accompanied by requisite **Bid security declaration in the prescribed format**,
- (iii) the validity of the offer is less than the validity stipulated in the tender,
- (iv) the offer does not meet the Pre-qualification criteria of the tender,
- (v) the bidder submits conditional offer/impose own terms and conditions/does not accept tender terms and conditions of the tender in full.
- (vi) if the tender is conditional,
- (vii) if all the documents required as per NIT are not uploaded.

In addition to above, a bidder may be disqualified if

(a). the bidder provides misleading or false information in the statements and documents submitted,

(b). Record of unsatisfactory performance during the last seven years, such as abandoning of work or rescinding of contract for which the reasons are attributable to the non-performance of the contractor or inordinate delays in completion or financial bankruptcy etc.

The decision of SMP, Kolkata in this regard shall be final and binding on the Bidder.

23. <u>Disparity in quoted rate/amount</u>: Any disparity between the rate quoted in figures and that of in words, the rate quoted in words shall prevail.

SCOPE OF WORK & SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Background

- 1.1 The Kaladan Multimodal Transit Transport Project (KMTTP) was jointly identified by India and Myanmar to create a multi modal mode of transport for shipment of cargo. KMTTP envisages a waterway trade route from Sittwe Port to Paletwa (158 Kms) along the river Kaladan and road route from Paletwa to India-Myanmar border of 110Kms.
- 1.2 The Ministry of External Affairs, (MEA) Government of India (GoI), has appointed Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) as the Project Development Consultant (PDC), for "Kaladan Multimodal Transit Transport Project" in Myanmar.
- 1.3 Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI), is Government of India body under the Ministry of Shipping, having its registered office at A-13, Sector 1, Noida, Uttar Pradesh (201301), India is the PDC (Project Development Consultant) appointed by MEA.

2. **Objective**

- 2.1 With the background mentioned above, Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata (SMP, Kolkata) on behalf of IWAI invites Bids from reputed organizations (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor") having experience primarily in "Supply of Spares for Cargo Handling Equipment's in KMTT Project, Myanmar."
- 2.2 The Employer's Requirements are that the Contractor shall carryout the Procurement of materials, supply, Transportation, of the Equipment spares at Sittwe, Myanmar, along with all associated items of works as outlined in this tender document. For this purpose, the Contractor shall conduct all necessary approvals & follow compliance by himself regarding the correctness of the data furnished vis-à-vis actual condition. No claim whatsoever will be entertained for any variation between the actual site condition met with during the execution of the work and those indicated herein.
- 2.3 The overall responsibility of the Contractor will encompass all the jobs required for carrying out this project from concept to commissioning, adhering to the time schedule, quality parameters and with no extra time & cost overrun. The Contractor will have to work in close co-ordination with EIC & his deputed team and all major decisions shall be taken in consultation with them.

3 Scope of Work

The broad scope of work of the Contractor is as below, but not limited to this. In case any associated work is required for successful execution of the project then the Contractor shall also organize the same. The scope of work shall include but not limited to the following:

- Supply of Spares for Cargo Handling Equipment's at KMTT Project, Sittwe, Myanmar.
- Provide necessary supporting documents i.e. OEM certificates, insurance certificate, tax/ custom/ duties paid certificate at all relevant locations.
- OEM warranty/ guarantee certificates and all other relevant documents.

- Inspection and handing over of the spares to nominated person of the employer at Siitwe, Myanmar.
- The contractor shall replace the spares under warranty and supply the same at Sittwe, Myanmar at no extra cost to the employer. In case of any repair/ servicing work in warranty, the same shall be provided in Sittwe, Myanmar at no extra cost to the employer.

The list of spares is indicated in Bill of Quantities.

Note: All the spares in the scope of the tender have to be physically checked and handed over to the MEA/ IWAI/SMPK representative at Sittwe Port. All due clearances of customs and other formalities have to be done by the contactor in Sittwe. Prices to include all transportation, taxes and duties applicable in relevant countries. The contractor shall ensure that the spares being supplied are brand new, unused and adheres to the specification of the Equipment model number.

4 <u>Preliminary Works</u>

- (a) The Contractor has to work out the detailed list of spares of Cargo Handling Equipment's, to be procured and take concurrence from the "Engineer-In-Charge (EIC) or Engineer" who is authorized to direct, supervise and be in-charge of the works on behalf of the Employer.
- (b) After placing the purchase order for the final list of spares, the contractor shall submit the same to EIC.
- (c) The Contractor is fully responsible for delivering a safe, sound, durable and quality spares conforming to the requirements as specified in the Tender document.

5 <u>Procurement</u>

- (a) The Contractor shall procure and supply all the necessary/ listed/ of spares from the OEM and shall submit the proof of the same considering the timelines as per the tender document.
- (b) The Contractor shall make its own arrangement for safe storage, handling of material and machinery procured and safe delivery at designated site i.e. Sittwe, Myanmar.

6 Site Organization

The Contractor shall depute well - qualified officers / team, having sufficient experience in supply of spares as per the scope of work of this tender document. If the progress of work is found unsatisfactory during the currency of the Contract, the Contractor shall promptly mobilize additional personnel / resources for ensuring satisfactory progress and timely completion of the proposed work, as per direction of & satisfaction of EIC and also obtain necessary clearances to satisfy all the conditions of the contract without extra cost to the Employer.

7 Materials

7.1 All materials to be procured for the work, shall be in accordance with the specifications laid down.

- 7.2 The Contractor shall use materials bearing ISI Certification mark unless otherwise specified or allowed in writing by the EIC and / or his representative. Any material banned by the Employer / Government shall not be used in the work.
- 7.3 The Contractor shall submit to the EIC and / or his representative, samples along with brand of all materials for approval from OEM supplier and its Manufacturer's test certificate.
- 7.4 The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the safe custody of the materials till the Handover of the materials.
- 7.5 In case of item for which approved make is not given, the Contractor shall with the prior approval of the EIC and / or his representative procure the same of first quality and satisfy the EIC and / or his representative before use in the works.
- 7.6 Materials shall be brought to sites in original packings. Manufacturer's test certificates and /or invoices for all materials shall be handed over to the EIC and / or his representative on demand. In case of any contradiction between the approved makes specified and mentioned in the specifications, the decision of the EIC and / or his representative shall be final and binding on the Contractor.
- 7.7 EIC and / or his representative reserves the right to have any or all random samples of materials checked/tested by an approved test house. The Contractor will bear all such test fees and organise other liaison works including all other incidental charges such as freight, handling, packing etc.
- 7.8 If at any stage of execution of work, EIC and / or his representative feels that the particular materials are not suitable to be used in any component of the structure covered under "the scope of work" the EIC and / or his representative may order re-testing of the materials as per relevant specifications, IS code and sound engineering practice from any approved laboratory. The cost of samples for such testing and the test charges including transportation of samples shall be borne by the Contractor. The rejected material either after the initial test of after retesting, as per the case may be / shall be immediately removed from the site of work by the Contractor at his own cost.
- 7.9 Any material used on work without prior inspection and testing (where testing is necessary) and approval of the EIC is / are liable to be considered unauthorized, defective and not accepted by the EIC and the EIC shall have full powers to order removal of any or all of the materials brought at site by the Contractor which are not in accordance with the Contract specifications or do not conform in character of quality to samples approved by him. In case of default on the part of the Contractor in removing rejected materials and any work executed with such unaccepted materials, the EIC shall be at liberty to have them removed and / or dismantled by other means at the risk and cost of the Contractor.
- 7.10The EIC and / or his representative shall have full powers to substitute the rejected materials with the acceptable ones and in the event of Contractor refusing to comply, he may ask the same to be supplied by other means at the risk and cost of the Contractor.

Special Conditions of Contract

1. Terms of Payment:

- (a) The total Contract Price payable under the Contract shall be stipulated in the Letter of Award (LoA) & thereupon shall become part of this Contract and be paid in accordance with the terms hereon. The price quoted will squarely and totally include all the charges to be paid to the Contractor by the Employer except for GST, which shall be paid as per the Government provisions effective at the time of release of payments.
- (b) All the payments shall be made in Indian Rupees (INR) only and shall be subject to applicable Indian Laws for the purpose of taxation, if any.
- (c) The contactor has to cater for any foreign exchange fluctuation for payment to parties in Myanmar, no extra payment will be made on account of such fluctuations.
- (d) Bills for the work executed / materials supplied in accordance with the work order / contract shall be prepared on the basis of detailed measurements/ certification/ verification recorded as described hereinbefore and processed for payments. The payment shall be made on completion of respective item of BoQ in all respect for example payment for supply of spares for Godrej GX 3TD Forklifts 3T 08 Nos will be made when all the listed items for the same are supplied.
- (e) The complete invoices in all respects, duly certified by PDC/Authority's representative, is to be submitted to 'The Chief Mechanical Engineer, Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata 8, Garden Reach Road, Kolkata-700043, who shall process the same after due verification. The payment shall be paid at the earliest through RTGS/NEFT, in favour of contractor.
- (f) Payment of on account bill shall be made on the EIC's and / or his representative certifying the sum to which the Contractor is considered entitled by way of interim payment.
- (g) The contractor shall submit warrantee/ Guarantee certificate of all the items to be supplied, before final handing over and acceptance by the EIC and or his representative.

2. <u>Mode of Payment</u>: All payment including refund of Earnest Money/ Security Deposit will be made through Electronic Clearing System (ECS). To facilitate payment through ECS, the tenderers will have to furnish the following information. The account shall have to be with a bank within the ECS zone prescribed by the RBI.

3. Measurement:-

(i) All items of work supplied by the Contractor in accordance with the provision of the contract having a financial value shall be verified by the employer's representative/ EIC and/ or his representative so that a complete record of the measurements is available for all

the works executed under the contract and the value of the work executed can be ascertained and determined there from.

(ii) Verification/ certification of the supplied items as per the BOQ shall be taken jointly by the EIC or his authorized representative and Contractor or his authorized representative.

(iii) In case the Contractor or his authorized representative does not attend to the joint verification/ certification at the prefixed date and time after due notice, the verification/ certification taken by the EIC and / or his representative shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

- 4. <u>Completion period</u>: Description of work vis-s-vis its completion period is as mentioned below:
- (a) The Contractor will have to enter into Contract Agreement within 21 days from the date of issuance of LoA, which will constitute of all correspondences and terms & conditions exchanged from time to time, between the Employer and the successful Bidder.
- (b) The Contract duration for the entire scope of work for supply of spares for cargo handling equipment at KMTT Project Sittwe, Myanmar with all associated items of works shall be Three (3) months from the date of issue of LoA followed by the Warrantee/ Guarantee as per the OEM.
- (c) Contractor shall ensure timely supply of the spare items as per the timelines defined in the Tender document.

5. <u>Liquidated Damage</u>: In case the work is not completed within the stipulated completion period, liquidated damage (a) $\frac{1}{2}$ % per week subject to a maximum of 10% of the each work order value will be deducted from the bill.

6. <u>Performance Security</u>: (For All Bidders including MSE Registered Firms)

The Contractor shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 3% of the contract value of the work as Performance Security in the form of an irrevocable bank guarantee bond of any nationalized / scheduled bank of India in accordance with the format prescribed within 15 days of the issuance of the LoA as per the format provided by SMP.

The Performance Security shall be valid for 180 days beyond the completion of the work or final handing over of the work or the payment of the final bill payable in accordance with agreement condition whichever is later, provided the EIC is satisfied that there is no demand outstanding against the Contractor. No claim shall be made against such bank guarantee and such bank guarantee shall be returned to the Contractor after 180 days of the completion of the Contract period. In case of extension of time for completion, the Contractor shall get the validity of the Performance Bank Guarantee extended to cover such extension of time of the work also.

7. Location of Assignment: Sitwe, Myanmar

8. The contract period is for Three (3) months from the date of issue of LoA.

9. <u>Risk Purchase</u>: Any non-performance on the part of the contractor or on the part of his subcontractor(s) due to industrial relation problems, non-supply of materials etc., shall debar the contractor from getting payment. SMP, Kolkata reserves the right to get the work done through any other agency or departmentally and the difference of cost shall be borne by the contractor under risk purchase.

(i) Amicable settlement : If any dispute or difference or claims of any kind arises between the Contractor and SMP, Kolkata in connection with interpretation or application of any terms and conditions or any matter or thing in any way connected with or in connection with or arising out of the contract, or the rights, duties or liabilities of the parties under the contract, then the parties shall meet together promptly at the requests of any party in an effort to resolve such dispute, difference or claim by discussions between them.

(ii) Arbitration: In addition to what has been stated in this tender document on this issue, the following may be noted by the tenderer:

(a) <u>Arbitrators</u>: Failing amicable settlement, the dispute or differences or claims as the case may be, shall be finally settled by binding arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including all amendments thereof. The arbitration shall be by a panel of three Arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the parties. A party requiring arbitration shall appoint an Arbitrator in writing, inform the other party about such appointment and call upon the other party to appoint its Arbitrator and inform the party initiating such arbitration within 60 days. If the other party fails to appoint its Arbitrator shall take step in accordance with Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, including any amendment thereof.

(b) Place of Arbitration: The place/jurisdiction of arbitration shall be in Kolkata, West Bengal, India.

10. Any insurance coverage shall have to be arranged by the contractor at his own cost & liability.

11. Personal Protective Equipment: Personnel deployed by you should have Personal Protective Equipment as would be necessary for the given working condition.

12. Electricity, Water and Gas: The Contractor shall be responsible for the provision of all power, water and other services he may require for his execution of the Works.

13. All other terms and condition not mentioned separately would be governed by SMP's General Conditions of Contract Forms and Agreement as enclosed with this Tender Document.

INTEGRITY PACT

Between

Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata (SMP, Kolkata) hereinafter referred to as "The Principal/ Employer".

And

..... hereinafter referred to as "The Bidder/Contractor"

Preamble

In order to achieve these goals, an Independent External Monitor (IEM) appointed by the principal, will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

NOW, THEREFORE,

To avoid all forms of corruption by following a system that is fair, transparent and free from any influence/prejudiced dealings prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the contract to be entered into with a view to:-

Enabling the PRINCIPAL/EMPLOYER to get the contractual work executed and/or to obtain/dispose the desired said stores/ equipment at a competitive price in conformity with the defined specifications/ scope of work by avoiding the high cost and the distortionary impact of corruption on such work /procurement/ disposal and Enabling BIDDERs/ CONTRACTORs to abstain from bribing or indulging in any corrupt practice in order to secure the contract by providing assurance to them that their competitors will also abstain from bribing and other corrupt practices and the PRINCIPAL/EMPLOYER will commit to prevent corruption, in any form, by its officials by following transparent procedures.

Section 1 - Commitments of the Principal/ Employer.

- (1) The Principal commits itself to take measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - a. No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - b. The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal will, in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential/ additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution.
 - c. The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons.

(2). If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal Code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption (PC) Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

Section-2 -Commitments of the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s)

- (1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.
- a. The Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) will not directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.
- b. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidders into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contract, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- c. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- d. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the Agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principles, if any. Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers" shall be disclosed by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s). Further, as mentioned in the Guidelines, all the payments made to the Indian agent/representative have to be in Indian Rupees only. Copy of the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers" is annexed and marked as Annex-A.
- e. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- (2). The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section-3-Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 above, or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as considered appropriate.

Section 4-Compensation for damages

- (1) If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security.
- (2) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3 or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee.

Section 5-Previous transgression

- (1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years from the date of signing the Integrity pact with any other Company in any country conforming to the anti corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Undertaking / Enterprise in India, Major Ports/ Govt. Departments of India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- (2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or action can be taken as considered appropriate.

Section 6- Equal treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Sub-Contractors

- (1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact, and to submit it to the Principal before contract signing.
- (2) The Principal, will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders, Contractors and Sub-contractors.
- (3) The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7- Other Legal actions against violating Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)/ Sub Contractor(s)

The actions stipulated in this Integrity pact are without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with provisions of the extant law in force relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.

Section 8 - Role of Independent External Monitor(IEM):

(a) The task of the Monitors shall be to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this pact.

(b) The Monitors shall not be subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and shall perform their functions neutrally and independently.

(c) Both the parties accept that the Monitors have the right to access all the documents relating to the contract.

(d) As soon as the Monitor notices, or has reason to believe, a violation of this pact, he will so inform the authority designated by the Principal and the Chief Vigilance Officer of Kolkata Prot Trust.

(e) The BIDDER/ CONTRACTOR(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all contract documentation of the PRINCIPAL including that provided by the BIDDER/ CONTRACTOR. The BIDDER/ CONTRACTOR will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his contract documentation, if any. The same is applicable to sub-contractors. The Monitor shall be under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder/Contractor/ Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality.

(f) The Principal/ Employer will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the contract provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor, the option to participate in such meetings.

(g) The Monitor will submit a written report to the designated Authority of Principal/ Employer/ Chief Vigilance Officer of Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal/ Employer/ Bidder/ Contractor and should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situation. BIDDER/ CONTRACTOR can approach the Independent External Monitor (s) appointed for the purposes of this Pact.

(h) As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or to take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.

(i) If the Monitor has reported to the Principal substantiated suspicion of an offence under the relevant IPC/PCA, and the Principal/ Employer has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.

(j) The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

Section 9 – Facilitation of Investigation:

In case of any allegation of violation of any provisions of this Pact or payment of commission, the PRINCIPAL/EMPLOYER or its agencies shall be entitled to examine all the documents including the Books of Accounts of the BIDDER/CONTRACTORS and the BIDDER/CONTRACTOR shall provide necessary information and documents **in English** and shall extend all possible help for the purpose of such examination.

Section 10 - Pact Duration:

The pact beings with when both parties have legally signed it and will extend upto 2 years or the complete execution of the contract including warranty period whichever is later. In case bidder/contractor is unsuccessful this Integrity Pact shall expire after 6 months from the date of signing of the contract.

If any claim is made/lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by Chairman, SMP Kolkata.

Section 11 - Other Provisions:

- (1) This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal in Kolkata.
- (2) Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing in English.
- (3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- (4) Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the reminder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

GUIDELINES FOR INDIAN AGENTS OF FOREIGN SUPPLIERS

- 1.1 There shall be compulsory registration of Indian agents of Foreign suppliers for all Tenders. An agent who is not registered with SMP, Kolkatashall apply for registration in the prescribed Application-Form.
- 1.2 Registered agents will file an authenticated Photostat copy (duly attested by a Notary Public)/Original certificate of the principal confirming the agency agreement and giving the status being enjoyed by the agent and the commission/ remuneration/salary/retainer ship being paid by the principal to the agent before the placement of order by SMP Kolkata.
- 1.3 Wherever the Indian representatives have communicated on behalf of their principals and the foreign parties have stated that they are not paying any commission to the Indian agents, and the Indian representative is working on the basis of salary or as retainer, a written declaration to this effect should be submitted by the party (i.e. Principal) before finalizing the order.

2.0 DISCLOSURE OF PARTICULARS OF AGENTS/REPRESENTATIVES IN INDIA. IF ANY.

- 2.1 Tenderers of Foreign nationality shall furnish the following details in their offer:
- 2.1.1 The name and address of the agents/representatives in India, if any and the extent of authorization and authority given to commit the Principals. In case the agent/representative be a foreign Company, it is to be conformed whether it is real substantial Company and details of the same shall be furnished.
- 2.1.2 The amount of commission/ remuneration included in the quoted price(s) for such agents/ representatives in India.
- 2.1.3 Confirmation of the Tenderer that the commission/remuneration if any, payable to his agents/ representatives in India, is to be paid by SMP, Kolkatain Indian Rupees only.

2.2 Tenderers of Indian Nationality shall furnish the following details in their offers:

- 2.2.1 The name and address of the foreign principals indicating their nationality as well as their status, i.e. whether manufacturer or agents of manufacturer holding the Letter of Authority of the Principal specifically authorizing the agent to make an offer in India in response to tender either directly or through the agents /representatives.
- 2.2.2 The amount of commission/remuneration included in the price(s) quoted by the Tenderer for himself.
- 2.2.3 Confirmation of the foreign principals of the Tenderer that the commission/remunerations, if any, reserved for the Tenderer in the quoted price(s), is to be paid by SMP, Kolkatain India in equivalent Indian Rupees.
- 2.3 In either case, in the event of contract materializing, the terms of payment will provide for payment of the commission/remuneration, if any payable to the agents/representatives in India in Indian Rupees on expiry of 90 days after the discharge of the obligations under the contract.
- 2.4 Failure to furnish correct and detailed information as called for in paragraph-2.0 above will render the concerned tender liable for rejection or in the event of a contract materializing, the same liable to termination by SMP Kolkata. Besides this there would be a penalty of banning business dealings with SMP, Kolkata or damage or payment of a named sum.
