1.0 **GENERAL**

The work as described in the tender shall be executed in Haldia and in accordance with the attached General Conditions of Contract, Special Conditions of Contract, Particular Specifications, Drawings (if any) & detailed Bill Of Quantities. Location Plan of the place of work might be inspected at the office of the Sr. Dy.Manager(IZ&R) (I&CF) on any working day before quoting for the tender.

2.0 **EARNEST MONEY**

- 2.1 An Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs 8,750.00** [Rupees Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Only] Enlisted Class A & Class B Contractors of I&CF division may be exempted from depositing the earnest money on submission of valid document of requisite security deposit for enlistment. 1. GENERAL

These provisions though given in a separate section are part of the tender documents which must be read as a whole, the various sections being complementary to one another and are to be taken as mutually explanatory. These provisions shall be read in conjunction with the other parts of the tender documents viz. General Conditions of Contract, Notice Inviting Tenders, Instructions to Bidders, Particular Specifications, Drawings, Bill of Quantities and other documents forming part of the Contract. In case of any discrepancy or ambiguity in the documents, the order of precedence of the documents as stated below will apply. In particular, these provisions will over ride those in the General Conditions provided there is discrepancy between them.

2. CORRELATION AND ORDER OF PRECEDENCE OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

If the stipulations in the various tender documents be found to be at variance in any respect, one will override others (but only to the extent that these are at variance) in the order of precedence as given in the list below, i.e. any particular item in the list will take precedence over all those placed lower down in the list.

Order letter.

Bill of Quantities.

Drawings.

Particular Specifications.

Special Conditions of Contract.

General Conditions of Contract.

In case of any dispute, question or difference either during the execution of the work or any other time as to any matter or thing connected with or arising out of this Contract, the decision of the Sr. Dy. Manager (IZ & R, I&CF), Haldia Dock Complex, thereon shall be final and binding upon all parties.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The proposed Geo-technical Examination shall be carried out at 12 (twelve) locations maximum in the extended area of G.C. Berth inside Haldia Dock Complex. Boreholes shall be made up to a depth of 30 M (maximum) below the existing ground level for conducting *in situ* soil tests and for recovery of soil samples for laboratory tests enumerated and described in the detailed Bill of Quantities in Volume-II of the tender document. The work includes preparation and submission of detailed report as described in Item no.-10 of B.O.Q. in Volume-II of the tender document including recommendation for design of foundation for bulk cargo / container stack yard(Hardstand) and ground improvement technique.

The area of work is shown in Drawing No. H-Misc.-306 ('Area of Work for Geotechnical Examination **in the Extended area of G. C. Birth in connection with construction of common users' railway siding/Hardstand inside Haldia Dock Complex**') attached to this tender document.

Specific locations of the boreholes shall be conveyed to the successful bidder prior to commencement of work.

The methodology and volume of soil sampling, *in situ* tests and laboratory tests shall be as described in the Bill of Quantities in Volume-II of the tender document. The contractor shall provide all necessary, tools & plants along with accessories, materials, fuel, skilled and unskilled personnel, supervision, etc. at the site, as well as laboratory facilities and staff necessary for expeditious completion of the work. The contractor will also carry out any other appurtenant works which may be required for successful completion of the project.

4. LOCATION

The work is to be carried out at 12 (twelve) locations maximum in the extended area of G.C. Berth inside Haldia Dock Complex. The overall area of work is shown in Drg No. H-Misc.-306 attached to this tender document.

5. ACCESS TO THE SITE

- (a) **By Road :-** All-weather hard top bituminous road approachable from NH-41 exists right up to the area of work.
- (b) **By Rail :-** S. E. Railway branch line connects Haldia with the Panskura Railway Station.

6. INSPECTION OF SITE

The Bidder shall inspect the site of work and thoroughly familiarise himself with the nature of work, site conditions, and access to the site and location before submission of the tender. He should contact the Sr. Dy. Manager (IZ&R) (I&CF), Haldia Dock Complex at his office at Chiranjibpur, Haldia or the Dy. Manager (IZ&R: I&CF), at his office at Chiranjibpur, Haldia for collecting information about the work and site before submission of the tender. No excuse will be entertained afterwards on the above ground. In case any part of the site cannot be handed over to the successful Bidder in time, no compensation for loss of labour or any other cause nor any claim will be entertained by the Trustees. Suitable extension of time may, however, be granted to the successful bidder (hereinafter referred to as 'contractor') on these grounds, if applied for.

7. SITE CONDITIONS

a) Rainfall:

This region is mainly exposed to south-west monsoon from June to September and an average monthly rainfall of over 225 mm is experienced (July and August are the wettest months having monthly rainfall as high as 330 mm). During the north-east monsoon period from November to February, a monthly average rainfall of less than 50 mm is experienced. The average annual rainfall is around 1500 mm and the average number of rainy days in a year with rainfall of 25 mm or more is about 20.

b) Temperature:

Temperature in the hotter months between April and May vary between 40°C and 45°C. In colder months, the temperature fluctuates between 6.5°C and 10°C.

8. TIME OF COMPLETION

The work is extremely urgent and must be completed in all respects within **2(Two) months** from the date of placement of work order, including preliminary time and mobilisation period.

9. NIGHT, HOLIDAY OR SUNDAY WORK

Subject to provisions in local Acts and any statutes of the State, the Contractor shall arrange for working on Holidays and Sundays whenever so desired by the Engineer to expedite progress and complete the works in time.

The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional payment for taking up works on Holidays and Sundays. The Contractor should be prepared to resort to round-the-clock working by following shift timings for labour.

10. MAINTENANCE PERIOD

There shall be no maintenance period for the contract.

11. PARTICULARS OF EXISTING WORKS

Such information as maybe given in the specification as to the existing features and works are given without warranty of accuracy and neither the Trustees nor the Engineer will be liable for any discrepancies therein.

12. SAFETY MEASURES

The contractor shall adhere to safe construction practice, guard against hazardous and unsafe working conditions and follow all safety precautions for prevention of injury or accidents and safeguarding life and property. The contractor shall comply with relevant provisions of Dock Workers (Safety, Health and Welfare) Act – 1986 and **as per the provision of The Dock Workers (Safety, Health & Welfare) Regulations, 1990, the contractor shall appoint a ‘Responsible Person’ and a ‘Safety Officer’ for his work** and Safety Officer of the Trustees or Safety Inspectors shall be afforded all facilities for inspection of the works, tools, plant, machineries, equipments etc. wherever so required. The contractor shall further comply with any instruction issued by the Engineer, Trustees’ Safety Officer, Safety Inspector in regards to safety which may relate to temporary, enabling or permanent works, working of tools, plants, machineries, equipments, means of access or any other aspect.

The contractor shall provide all necessary first aid measures, rescue and life saving equipment to be available in proper condition.

The contractor shall provide PPE’s (Personal Protective Equipments) such as, helmet, safety shoe etc. to all workers and shall also provide job specific PPE’s e.g. safety belts for working at heights; protective face and eye shield, goggles, hand gloves for welding / gas cutting works; protective foot wear and gloves for hot works facemasks, gloves and overalls for painting works, mixing and handling materials etc , as directed by the Engineer.

All safety rules shall be strictly followed while working on live electrical systems or installations as stipulated in the relevant safety codes.

The successful bidder shall also ensure that –

- (i) No damage is caused to plants and vegetations unless the same is required for execution of the project proper.
- (ii) The work shall not pollute any source of water / land / air surrounding the work site so as to affect adversely the quality or appearance thereof or cause injury or death to animal and plant life.
- (iii) His office & labour hutment etc. shall be maintained in a clean and hygienic condition throughout the period of their use and different effluents of the labour hutment shall have to be disposed off suitably.

The contractor shall adopt all the above safety measures at his own cost.

14. POWER SUPPLY

If available, suitable power point may be arranged by the Trustees at the nearest existing supply point of the site of the work on receipt of request letter from the Contractor to that effect. All necessary arrangements for the distribution at site will have to be made by the Contractor at his own cost as approved by the Trustees’ Plant and Equipment Division. However, no guarantee is ensured for power supply from Trustees’ end.

Charge for consumption of power shall be periodically recovered from the Contractor’s Bill at the rates with surcharges of WBSEB as amended from time to time including installation and hire charges for meters, Govt. Duty as well as 19.25% overhead on electricity charges. The Trustees do not guarantee uninterrupted power supply from the above sources and Contractor shall not be compensated for any delay in providing power supply. The Contractor shall have to arrange for the supply of power at his own cost during such periods.

15. WATER

The Contractor will arrange for supply of water both for drinking and for construction or other purposes at his own cost.

16. KEEPING THE SITE AND WORKING AREA CLEAR

The contractor shall at all times keep the site and working areas free from all surplus materials, rubbish and offensive matter all of which shall be disposed off in a manner to be approved by the Engineer's Representative.

17. CONSTRUCTION OF SITE OFFICE, STORE ETC.

On an application from the contractor, land near to the site of work will be allotted by the Trustees for the construction of Site Office, Store etc. The contractor shall build office, sheds etc. on the land allotted to him as approved by the Engineer or his representative and shall maintain a clean hygienic condition throughout the period of their use. The contractor shall maintain a Site Order Book at his site office and all orders and instructions issued to him from time to time by the Engineer or his representative will be recorded in the Site Order Book. The contractor shall promptly sign each entry as a token of having received such orders. Upon completion of the work, the contractor shall dismantle his site office.

18. METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

Unless otherwise specified in the Particular Specifications and Bill of Quantities, the work shall be measured according to the existing P.W.D.'s (Building Work: latest revision & Road Work: latest revision) Schedule of Rates. For details of measurement not covered by the above, relevant parts of IS-1200 [latest revision] and SP: 27 [latest revision] of B.I.S. shall be referred to.

19. PAYMENT

On account payment to the contractor shall be arranged as and when required at the discretion of the Sr. Dy. Manager (IZ & R, I&CF) on the basis of measurements of completed works at the quoted rates in the Bill of Quantities. 12. The Employees State Insurance Act, 1948 & Employees State Insurance (Amendment) Act ,1989
13. Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act,1986
14. The Maternity Benefits Act 1961
15. Interstate Migrant Workmen (Regulation Of Employment & Conditions Of Service) Act, 1979.

24. FORCE MAJEURE

In the event of either party rendered unable by Force Majeure to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under the Contract, relevant obligation of the party affected by such Force Majeure shall upon Notification to the other party be suspended for the period which Force Majeure events lasts. The cost and loss sustained by the either party shall be borne by the respective parties.

The term “Force Majeure” as employed shall mean the events as below:

- (i) riot (unless solely restricted to or perpetuated by employees of the Contractor or his subcontractors / suppliers or occurring outside India) so far as it is uninsurable;
- (ii) war, hostilities (whether war be declared or Not), invasion, directed to or by India or act of foreign enemies, directed to India;
- (iii) rebellion, revolutions, insurrection, or military or usurped power, or civil war in India;
- (iv) fire, flood, cyclone, hurricane and acts of God.

Time of performance shall be extended by the period of delay, which is directly caused by the Force Majeure. Upon the occurrence of such cause and upon its termination, the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid shall Notify the other party in writing immediately but not later than forty eight hours of the alleged are beginning and ending thereof, giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of his claim.

Time of performance of the relative obligation suspended by the Force Majeure shall stand extended by the period for which such event lasts and affects the relative obligation directly. Such extension of time shall be without prejudice to the provision that time is essence of the Contract and any other terms and conditions related to time of completion as may be provided elsewhere in the Contract.

If the work is affected by Force Majeure lasting for more than 60 days at a stretch, the parties to the Contract shall settle the issue mutually.

25. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

If the contractor fails to complete the work in time, he shall pay compensation (Liquidated Damage) to the Trustees as per Clause No. 8.2 (a) of G.C.C.

26. SERVICE TAX & CENVAT

Service Tax is not leviable for civil works in the port and if the same is leviable, it will be paid extra by the Trustees. **The bidder shall not include Service Tax in his rates.** In case Service Tax is payable, the Contractor needs to be registered with the Central Excise for the service to be rendered and copy of the same shall be submitted to HDC.
